

# How to make automated payments to your savings account

You can make one-off or regular payments to your Newbury Building Society savings account online.

## How to make a payment via your bank

Visit your bank and provide them with the details below to make a payment to your Newbury Building Society account.

The Society uses NatWest bank to receive your funds and providing you have given us the correct reference (your 10-digit Newbury Building Society account number) they will be credited to your savings account. When you make a payment to us, the following bank details should be quoted:

**Account name:** Newbury Building Society

**Account number:** 00000000

**Sort Code:** 62-28-74

**Reference:** Your 10-digit Newbury Building Society savings account number.

**Account type:** Business

**Please note:** These bank details are to be used for standing orders and one off payments. Your bank will have a transaction/daily limit relating to the amount that you can transfer in this way. If the amount is more than your bank limit allows please contact us to request our CHAPS details which is a system that can be used for larger amounts.

You can also make an automated payment to your mortgage account with Newbury Building Society, please follow the same process as above but quote your mortgage account number as the reference.

All automated payments are subject to the terms and conditions of your account.
